Description of the charity's activities and outcomes:

The charity's mandate is to raise funds to promote and foster research into selective therapies to control or cure rare genetic diseases, specifically Hereditary Spastic Paraplegia 56 (SPG56).

SPG 56 is a rare, genetic, neurodegenerative disease resulting from a mutation in the gene CYP2U1.

SPG 56 presents with progressive deterioration in mobility as well as intellectual disability and subclinical axonal neuropathy. There is currently no cure and there are no treatments that slow or delay the disease progression.

GC4K's strategic priority is initiating and financing 1) a Drug Repurposing Study and 2) an AAV9 Gene Therapy Study (gene addition) with the objective of finding a cure for SPG 56 and similar neurodegenerative diseases.
